Introduction: *(Brief History + Highlights; each in 3-4lines)*

1. The College was established in the year **1975** as an extension of Gauri Pathshala Inter College (established in 1905). The primary aim of the establishment of this College in the thick locality of Malviya Nagar (Ahiyapur), was to educate and empower the girls of this area who were unable to go to the University for higher education. Late Justice Mahesh Prasad Mehrotra, Late Smt. Rani Tandon and late Shri Hari Mohan Das Tandon were founder members of the college management. The college started with BA course in the following subjects – **Hindi, Sanskrit, English, Political Science, Economics, Ancient History, Education, Music Vocal and Tabla**. New courses **B.Com and PhD** (Political Science and Hindi) have been started in the year 2018 and 2022 respectively. The College attained Central status and became a constituent of the University of Allahabad in 2005 and received '**B' grade by NAAC in the year 2005 and 2015**. To ensure quality education for girls in the outskirts of Allahabad, an additional branch was also **established at Mahewa in 2024**.

- To inculcate creative impulse and critical thinking in the girl students.
- To sensitize them towards burning social issues such that they may be responsive to social needs.
- To empower them so that they may become economically independent and self-sufficient enriched with moral values and may become responsible citizens of the nation.

GENERAL ACTIVITIES OF NSS

1. International Yoga Day (21 June 2025)

SEVEN-DAY SPECIAL NSS CAMP REPORT (10–16 March 2026)

Day 1 – 10 March 2026 (Inaugural Session)

The seven-day Special Camp of NSS Unit 055 commenced on 10 March 2026 at Rajarshi Tandon Mahila Mahavidyalaya, a constituent college of the University of Allahabad.
